### CHILDREN



Obtaining fake pills believing they are real

### RECREATIONAL



Occasional use (not seeking fentanyl)

### LEGACY



Started with RX and supplementing (may or may not be seeking fentanyl)

### DEPENDENT



Addict (seeking fentanyl)
