Reverse an Opioid Overdose with Naloxone

CHECK

Check for breathing and try to wake the person up.



CALL

2

Call 911.



BREATHE

Support breathing with chest compressions (with or without rescue breathing).



SPRAY

If no response, administer naloxone. See reverse for detailed instructions for each type of naloxone applicator.

STAY

Continue chest compressions until the person is breathing on their own. Place the person on their side and stay until help arrives.

Recognizing an Opioid Overdose

Is Naloxone still effective after the expiration date?

The effectiveness of Naloxone, a medication used to reverse opioid overdose, may decrease after its expiration date. However, studies have shown that in many cases, expired Naloxone can still be partially effective. It is recommended to obtain a new dose if possible, but if no other options are available, using an expired Naloxone might still provide some benefit in an emergency situation. It is essential to seek medical help immediately after administering Naloxone and to store it properly to ensure its effectiveness.

REMOVE

REMOVE Kloxxado® nasal spray from the box. Peel off the back tab with the triangle (p) to open the Kloxxado™ nasal spray blister.



HOLD

HOLD it with your thumb on the bottom and your first and middle fingers on either side of the nozzie.



INSERT

INSERT the tip of the nozzle into one nostril until your fingers are against the bottom of the person's nose.



PRESS

PRESS the plunger firmly to give the dose of Kloxxado® nasal spray.
