
HOW CAN I SPOT AN OPIOID OVERDOSE?

- HAVE BLUE OR GRAY SKIN OR LIPS
- HAVE COLD OR CLAMMY SKIN.




NALOXONE IS USER-FRIENDLY AND COMPACT, MAKING IT EASY TO CARRY.





DESPITE ITS EFFECTIVENESS, NALOXONE'S EFFECTS
ARE TEMPORARY. SOME OPIOIDS MAY OUTLAST

INSERT THE TIP OF THE NOZZLE INTO ONE NOSTRIL.
