Social media can help us connect, share, and have fun. But it can also be used to sell **dangerous drugs**.



NOT EVERYTHING ONLINE IS SAFE.



People aren't always who they say they are.



Messages can disappear.



Some people are trying to sell dangerous drugs.



HOW IT CAN HAPPEN



Someone sends a message or adds you.



They offer pills or something "safe."



They say it's no big deal.

It can happen faster than you think.



WHAT YOU SHOULD KNOW



Pills online may be fake.



They can contain fentanyl.



You can't see, taste, or smell it.

ONE PILL CAN BE DEADLY.



WHY IT'S EASY TO GET TRICKED



It feels private.



Friends might be involved.



It looks normal online.



STAY SAFE ONLINE



Don't accept messages from people you don't know.



Don't take pills from anyone.



Talk to a trusted adult.



IF SOMETHING FEELS WRONG



Tell a trusted adult.



Stay with your friend.



Call 911 if someone is not responding.

You won't get in trouble for helping.



LOOK OUT FOR EACH OTHER.

Real friends help keep each other safe.
